

**Ordinance No. 43**

**An Ordinance Regulation Possession of Open Container of Any Intoxicating Liquor or Non-Intoxicating Malt Liquor Within the City of Badger and Imposing Penalties for Violation.**

The City Council of Badger Ordains:

**Section 1.** No person shall consume any intoxicating liquor or non-intoxicating malt liquor upon any public street, thoroughfare, sidewalk or alley in the City of Badger.

**Section 2.** No person shall have in his possession while upon any public street, thoroughfare, sidewalk or alley in the City of Badger any bottle or receptacle containing intoxicating liquor or non-intoxicating malt liquor which have been opened, or the seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed.

**Section 3. City Park.** At 10:00 p.m. this park is closed to everyone except campers. When the officer makes his rounds any non-campers in the park after 10:00 p.m. may be prosecuted.
