Ordinance No. 43

An Ordinance Regulation Possession of Open Container of Any Intoxicating Liquor or Non-Intoxicating Malt Liquor Within the City of Badger and Imposing Penalties for Violation.

The City Council of Badger Ordains:

Section 1. No person shall consume any intoxicating liquor or non-intoxicating malt liquor upon any public street, thoroughfare, sidewalk or alley in the City of Badger.

Section 2. No person shall have in his possession while upon any public street, thoroughfare, sidewalk or alley in the City of Badger any bottle or receptacle containing intoxicating liquor or non-intoxicating malt liquor which have been opened, or the seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed.

Section 3. City Park. At 10:00 p.m. this park is closed to everyone except campers. When the officer makes his rounds any non-campers in the park after 10:00 p.m. may be prosecuted.
